MEDIATION

- Have completed at least 40 hours of mediation training and within the last two years have completed at least five mediations serving as a mediator of which two may have been as a co-mediator or a member of a court-sponsored mandatory settlement conference; and
• Commit to earning ten CLE units in Alternative Dispute Resolution over the next three years; and
• Two (2) Letters of Reference from parties for whom the applicant has served as mediator or arbitrator.

ARBITRATION

- Admitted to the practice of law for at least ten years or have ten years of experience in the subject area/field in which you propose to arbitrate and have served as an arbitrator in at least five arbitrations

ALL ADR PANELS (as required by Calif. Rules of Court, Rule 10.781)

- Sign a certificate agreeing to comply with all applicable rules of court and ethical requirements; and
• Agree to serve as an ADR neutral on a pro bono or modest-means basis in at least one case per year, not to exceed eight hours, if requested by the court.
